Contributions are now invited for presentations as a *poster* to be displayed within the Biometrics Institute Conference Exhibition **PLUS** a *10 -15 mins presentation* within the conference. The exhibition of posters is limited to 8 (eight) exhibitors.

## Call for Posters

The abstract can be supported by up to 5 PowerPoint slides.

Submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Technical Committee of the Biometrics Institute on the basis of relevance and technical merit. If accepted you will be asked to prepare a poster to be displayed at this event and will be invited to give a 10 – 15 mins presentation on your poster content. Preference may be given to those organisations that are able to attend to their posters at the event.

Poster authors do not have to register for the Biometrics Institute Annual Australia Conference to present a poster unless they wish to attend the conference sessions. Academic and student registration rates are available for those wishing to attend the conference.

The Biometrics Institute Annual Australia Conference is organised by the Biometrics Institute, an independent not-for-profit membership organisation, founded in July 2001.

The mission of the Biometrics Institute is to be a forum for biometric users and other interested parties and to facilitate the wider use of biometrics.

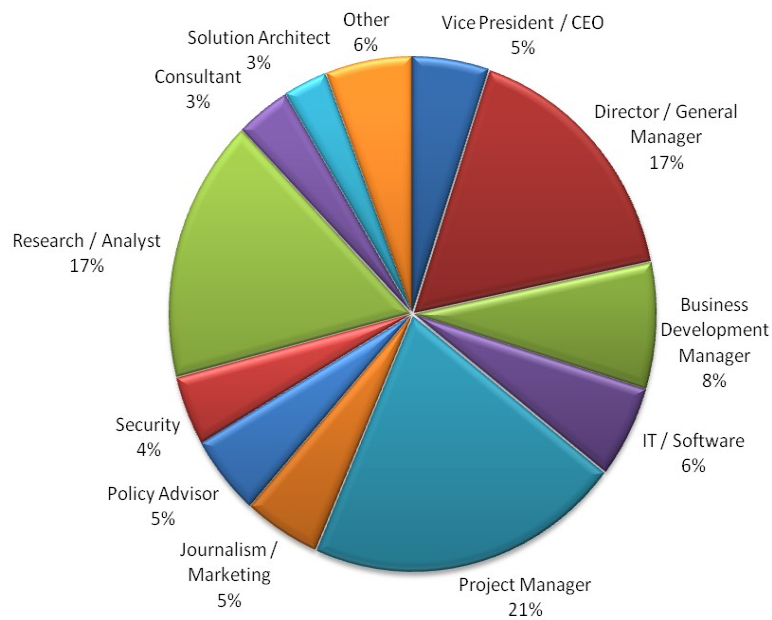
